BORROWING PRIVILEGES

- 30 items at any one time
- 14 days (optional 14 day renewal period up to maximum of 84 days)
- Late fees apply
- No access to Library Resources off campus
- No access to Western Sydney University Library Reserve items

LATE FEES



To ensure fair access to University Library resources for all library clients, fees accrue for the late return of all items.

The return date is indicated on the emailed loan receipt, and in your Library record.

- Standard items incur a fee of \$1.00 per item per DAY or part thereof.
- Recalled items not returned by designated date incur a fee of \$2.00 per item per DAY or part thereof.

Suspension: When items are overdue and/or overdue fees reach \$10, all borrowing privileges are suspended.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR

- Ensuring before you leave the Library that any Library item which you remove from the premises has been registered as borrowed.
- The safekeeping and return on or before the due date, as recorded in the library system, of items borrowed on your ID or Library card
- All materials you consult, whether borrowed for use outside the Library or not, and will be held liable for any loss, mutilation or other damage. The full cost of either repair or replacement shall on demand be payable to the University, together with a service fee.
