#### 12CAFS HELPING THE HOMELESS

The HSC Community and Family Studies course includes the study of marginalised groups such as Youth, People with Disabilities and Homeless People. Throughout second term, students explored diversity within the groups, prioritised specific needs and investigated the services required by each group to facilitate equity.

We were fortunate to have our very own Sue Beamer give a presentation about her volunteer work at Mama Lana's Community Foundation (MLCF). This organisation is wholly not-for-profit and is dedicated to helping the often-forgotten homeless and underprivileged community in the greater Penrith region. The foundation offers hot meals six nights a week, supplies food and toiletry packs, as well as clothing, sleeping bags, swags and blankets to keep the homeless and underprivileged warm during cold Penrith nights.

After Sue's presentation, our Year 12 CAFS students were motivated to donate to this very worthwhile cause. They set about assembling toiletry items in bags, back packs, handbags and tote bags. Some of the packs included scarves, beanies, note pads and pens and some included a note decorated by Alaina's daughter. All of these items are things we may take for granted but they are essential for meeting our basic needs, and especially important for people experiencing homelessness.




