Hosted by Wyndham College – Students bussed to Wyndham College (SHHS/ RHS – QHHS to walk) for **9am start in the Hall each day until 2pm** – buses to return them to 7-10 School

Day 1 – Mathematics Course levels outlined by HT Students then attend a series of classes in which the demands of courses are explained by expert staff. Students bring own lunch

Day 2 – English Course levels outlined by HT. Students proceed to a series of 40 min classes in which the expectations of the courses are explained by expert staff. BBQ Lunch provided. Students will complete a survey regarding the direction of their subject choices at this stage.

Wyndham College Open Night 11th March 2020

Dates for QHHS, RHS & SHHS were postponed due to COVID. **Schools will deliver information and guidance throughout Term 2 in their respective programs.**

Students will have access to additional resources to inform their decision making for senior subject selection. Students will be able to obtain online advice from the Careers Team through forums and messages. **GCR code : mike4xy**

Course choice surveys conducted over weeks 6-7 via online survey emailed to students and supported by phone interviews will provide information to create line structures for the schools.

- Students will be emailed notification of the date of their interview in the week prior. Interviews may be via phone if student is still on Distance Learning program. Students will meet with a member of the Collegiate Careers Team to discuss their career planning and subject choices.
- Students will have a Collegiate Stage 6 Package mailed to them at following the interview with a self-addressed envelope to return it to the selected school by post or in person 28th August.
- Cross campus Access course applications may be made at this time.
- EVET applications can be initiated at this interview.
- Support students will have individualised Transition Planning meetings during this term.

All students will need to have lodged their completed Personal details update / enrolment forms with the school they are selecting for Year 11 & 12 by **Friday 28th August 2020.**

Invitations will be sent to Parents early in Term 4 notifying of the respective dates and start times pertaining to each particular school.

Students will arrange their own transport to arrive at **Wyndham College at 8am**. Students will discover more about what it will be like to be a senior student at Wyndham.

Invitations will be sent to Parents early in Term 4 notifying of start time. Uniform can also be purchased/ ordered on this night.

Students accessing classes across campuses will be guided through :

- transport arrangements for their access class
- their roles and responsibilities and those of their home and host campuses
- key contact personnel
